We certainly count it a privilege to be partnered together with you for the sake of the Gospel going forth to the Korean people in South Korea's second largest city. By the grace of God each of us are enjoying good health and the bountiful provision that our Lord has graciously provided for us through your faithful support. Thank you for sacrificially investing in the Lord's work! Despite the frosty weather last month, we were able to continue with Gospel tract distribution at various points across our city of Busan. Last week, one man who received a tract called me later to ask some questions about what our tract said concerning eternal life. However, unfortunately this proud skeptic was not interested in listening to my response and abruptly ended the call only a few minutes into our conversation. Later on that day I took the time to write a long text message to him, using many Scripture verses to answer his objections to the Gospel and share the truth of Jesus Christ with him. I prayed that he would read what I sent him and turn to Christ for salvation. As I think of this man, I am reminded that God is long-suffering and not only desires the salvation of those with tender hearts but also of those who angrily oppose Him. In His great love, God mercifully provides many opportunities for people like this man to respond in faith and receive the life-transforming gift of eternal salvation.



Thank you so much for praying for Jungbu Independent Baptist Church. We are confident that the Lord will send more visitors our way in His timing. In the meantime we continue to minister to those who are coming regularly. I am currently preaching through the book of Romans on Sundays and preaching through the book of Ephesians on Wednesday nights. We recently worked to improve our church website by uploading a short video and adding two new pages ("Why should you be interested in the Bible?" and "Who is Jesus Christ?"). We pray that the Lord would use these detailed presentations of His truth to draw lost souls to Himself for salvation. It has been an encouragement to see that we have had several visitors to the church website nearly every day over the past month. Our desire is to use every opportunity available to proclaim the life-changing Gospel of Christ for the glory of God before our Savior's return in the clouds for His own.



We are grateful for how the Lord is working in the life of the young man attending our church. Last month he attended a conference for young adults held at the church we served at prior to starting Jungbu Independent Baptist Church. "College and career" aged adults from several sound churches around Korea were also in attendance. The young man returned from the conference encouraged after hearing good preaching and enjoying fellowship with other young people from like-minded churches for the first time. A few days after the conference, the Lord allowed this young man to re-establish contact with an old acquaintance who lives up in Korea's third largest city of Incheon. The Lord was obviously at work in this person's heart because the young man's friend was quite interested in the Gospel and seemed open to being counseled about salvation. The following Sunday the young man traveled up to Incheon and took his friend to visit a church that I had recommended to him. By the grace of God, Pastor Im Dong Sun (a national pastor friend whom I highly respect) was able to personally lead this precious soul to Christ after the morning service. The young man who attends our church was greatly moved that day at the salvation of his friend. Upon hearing this answer to prayer we greatly rejoiced at our Lord working to ordain this special opportunity for a precious soul to respond to the conviction of the Holy Spirit and freely trust the crucified and risen Lord Jesus Christ for salvation! May the Lord allow us to see Him work in this fashion again and again over the course of 2024!
